Designed as a problem-based pedagogy, students of the full-time programme will be exposed to 16-week Industrial Experience with industry firms and trained to solve real-world challenges and be career-ready upon graduation. Students will be awarded a direct honours based on their results.

- **OBTAIN ADVANCED STANDINGS & SCHOLARSHIP/ SPONSORSHIP**

An advanced standing of up to 1.5 years would be eligible for students with relevant diploma programmes. Scholarships/Sponsorships are available for eligible local candidates.

Every construction project combines a variety of complex challenges. The Bachelor of Construction Management (Building) (Honours) programme will equip you with the skills and knowledge to manage complexities in construction projects in Singapore and across the world. The programme incorporates content of Building Information Modelling teaching and projects which offers a niche speciality beyond the construction management discipline.

Graduates from the programme will embark on a diverse and exciting career opportunities to be employed as BIM Manager, Construction Manager, Project Manager, Quantity Surveyor, Facilities Manager, Property Developer and self-employed Consultant.

PROGRESSION PATHWAYS, DURATION & FEES

The Programme consists of 30 courses (320 credits) to be taught at BCA Academy, Singapore.

Full-Time - A Full-Time study may be completed in 2.5 years depending on prior qualification (advanced standings would be available for qualified candidate*). A typical Full-Time study without advanced standing is 4 years, with completion of 8 courses per year.

Part-Time - Depending on prior qualification, a Part-Time study may be completed in about 3.5 years (advanced standings would be available for qualified candidate*). A typical Part-Time study without advanced standing is about 5.5 years, with an average completion of 6 courses per year.
