INTRODUCTION

As part of the BCA's Covid-Safe Worksite Restart criteria, builders would need to establish and implement a system on Safe Management Measures (SMM)s to provide a safe working environment and minimise risks of further outbreaks. Builders would also need to appoint Safe Management Officers (SMO)s and Safe Distancing Officers (SDO)s as per the Restart criteria.

This course is designed for the appointed SMOs and SDOs to perform their duties more effectively.

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the session, participants will be able to:

- Establish and implement a system of SMMs to provide a safe working environment and minimise risks of further outbreaks.
- Perform duties of a SMO/SDO that include:
 - To coordinate implementation of SMMs, which includes identifying relevant risks, recommending and assisting in implementing measures to mitigate the risks, and communicating the measures to all personnel working in the workplace.
 - To conduct inspections and checks to ensure compliance at all times and to report and document any non-compliance found during the inspections.
 - To take immediate action to remedy any non-compliance found during the inspections and checks.
